Consider the following to budget for utilities:

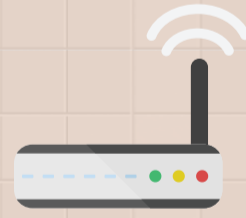
When budgeting for rental apartment utility costs, consider your average usage of electronics. Keep this in mind to budget appropriately.



Check with the property owner about the expected monthly costs of heating and gas. The cost will depend upon how often you use your gas or heater.



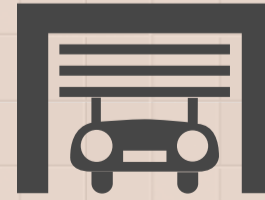
Depending upon the provider and the level of internet services you want to have, think about budgeting a certain amount for internet utility per month.
